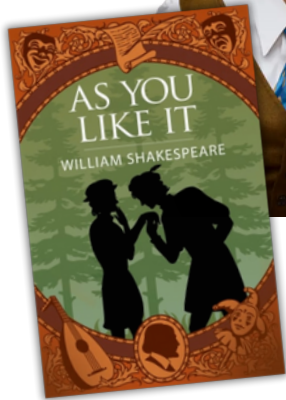

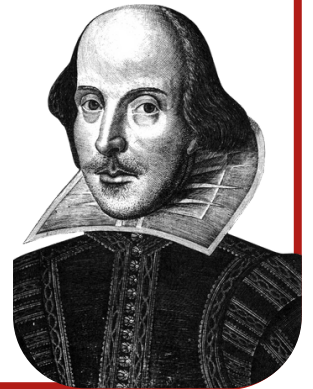

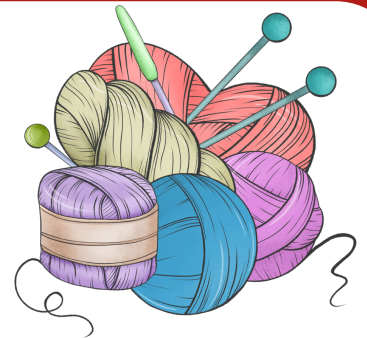

FRIENDLY FIBER CIRCLE WEDNESDAYS 3:30-4:30 P.M. SUNDERLAND BRANCH DROP-IN

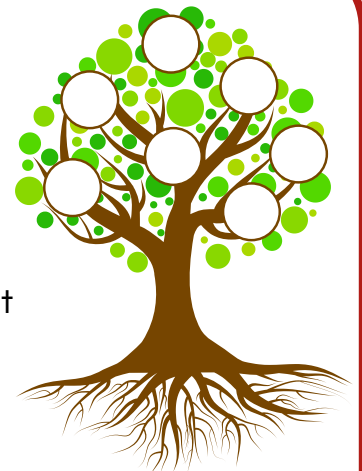

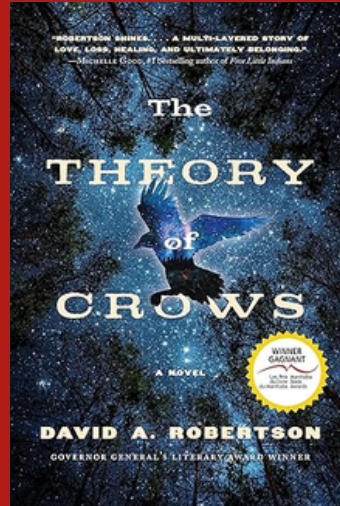
